




Report N:2404 "Aliens in America"








Aggressive aliens by state:

Almost half of the aliens living in each state are aggressive (they can hunt, and the basis of their diet is meat), but at the same time, they manage to hide it and work with people.



It turns out that aliens classify themselves as one of eight genders. But among them, just like us, the majority are men and women.



And here are a few more observations:



They try to choose unique, but quite earthly names. There are few repeating names among them: Dannie(23), Dory(22), Jan, Frannie(21)...

A certain percentage of their names go funny with their last names. People wouldn't call themselves that.

The data records 17,701 aliens with a unique surname of various ages. It's hard to believe that they simply have no relatives left. Most likely, they have a different principle of inheriting a family name, or they simply flew to Earth alone.

Some of their surnames have endings characteristic of surnames of other nationalities. Does this mean that before the census, these aliens had citizenship of other countries, or did they simply each take a surname whichever they liked?

All aliens have email, but, as if on purpose, they set up addresses on different servers. This makes it harder to keep track of them.

All living aliens are adults, so no more than three bearers of the same surname live in one state.

25 of their names consist of only two letters. And the longest name (Helen-elizabeth) has 14 letters. Because of this, the average name length for them is: 1.01244 letters.

Aliens of different species can belong to the same surname, which means they have a tradition of taking the surname of their husband or wife.

The choice of state and place of residence was clearly made with an eye on whether the state was rich and populous, and what its climate and nature were like.

The largest number of aggressive aliens are among flatwoods. But we suspected the greys.

Among them, 430 work as teachers.
